Floor Cleaner Technical Information

Lemon Gel is a versatile, solvent-free gel cleaner for medium-duty floor cleaning applications. The concentrated blend of soaps, non-ionic surfactants, amphoteric surfactants, biocides, dyes and fragrances is highly effective in the removal of a wide variety of heavy soils.

Following application, Lemon Gel may be readily burnished to yield a slip resistant shine.

Lemon Gel is suitable for use by mop or spray or mechanised scrubbing machine cleaning methods.

Primary features attributable to Lemon Gel are:

- Heavy duty bactericidal floor cleaner;
- Will remove dulled polish films;
- Clean lemon fresh fragrance;
- Effective damp mopping solution for a wide range of surfaces;
- Can be polished to give a slip resistant shine;
- Suitable for spray cleaning to remove dirt and heel marks.

Applications

Lemon Gel has found applications for hard surface floor cleaning in a wide variety of locations such as buildings, offices, entertainment facilities, healthcare and catering facilities.

Compatibility

Lemon Gel is compatible with all hard surface flooring type materials and will not stain or affect plastic surfaces.

Lemon Gel has been found suitable for use on PVC, rubber, sealed cork, sealed wood, terrazzo, ceramic tile and thermoplastic sheet flooring.

Lemon Gel has a storage life of not less than 36 months when stored in original containers in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area between 5 °C and 35 °C.

Directions for Use

Application:

General Mopping:

Dilute 1 part Lemon Gel to 120 parts of warm water.

Apply the solution by mopping using a well wrung out mop, and burnish to remove all floor marks and soils

Allow the floor to dry and then, if required, burnish further to improve the shine using a clean dry cloth.

Spray burnishing:

Dilute 1 part of Lemon Gel to 60 parts of water.

Apply by lightly spraying moving ahead of a commercial floor polishing machine fitted with a suitable nylon pad.

For use with machine scrubbers, use as directed for spray burnishing.
