Change was water regularly (after each batch).

Food preparation surfaces, floors, tiles 200ppm, 1 tablet in 7.5 litres. Allow to soak for 3 minutes and air dry or use disposable paper towels. Neutral (non cationic) detergent can be added to solution to aid cleaning.

Food preparation surfaces, floors, tiles 200ppm, 1 tablet in 5 litres. Allow to soak for 3 minutes and air dry or use disposable paper towels. Neutral (non cationic) detergent can be added to solution to aid cleaning.

Since many authorities have banned the use of bleach, NaDCC powders and tablets predominate the favoured method of chlorine disinfection for the food industry. Sanitab prevents any accidents happening. Its safe screw cap tub houses the tablets for up to five years. These small, white tablets are based on a dry chlorine donor, troclosene sodium (NaDCC), which is blended with effervescent components before being formed into tablets.

The result is a fast dissolving, highly convenient, safer and more accurate alternative to safeguard your food production and guarantee your product is safe for your customers.
